Plum Wine – Plum wine has pure quality and fruity aroma with provocative taste. The aromatic bouquet and velvet finish lingers elegantly without flaw; served chilled. 6 - 20

Murphy Goode Pinot Noir – Delicious cherry and plum flavors are accented by touches of black tea, rhubarb, and forest floor in this complex, medium-bodied wine. It's soft in feel, but has light tannins and enough acidity to give it some snap. 7 - 24

Doña Paula Malbec – Intense purplish red color. Sweet, spicy and intense aromas, with notes of red fruits and herbs. This wine is soft, velvety, fresh, and well balanced. 6 - 18

Cline Merlot – An elegant and full-bodied Merlot with complex cherry and raspberry flavors from the Sonoma Carneros region. 6 - 20

19 Crimes Shiraz – Criminally intense vanilla aromatics are balanced with ripe raspberry and plum fruits. Full and round bright-red with crimson hues give way to subtle sweetness. 6 - 18

Slow Press Cabernet Sauvignon – Generous and flavorful, it's concentrated and tannic, with medium-full body, a hint of sweetness and layers of dark cherry and plum fruit. 7 - 22

WHITE

Wines are listed from Sweet to Dry

Corvo Moscato – A sweet, vibrant and refreshing Moscato produced from grapes grown on the sunny hillside vineyards of Sicily. It offers delicate aromas of Mediterranean flowers with a bright, candied finish. 6 - 18

Fenn Valley Riesling – A semi-dry white wine with crisp acidity that is balanced by a touch of natural grape sugar. Some of the best Rieslings from North America come from Michigan, and this ranks right up there. 6 - 20

Caposaldo Pinot Grigio – Features a dry, crisp, vibrant texture and delicate aromas of white fruit, flowers and almonds. 6 - 18

Martin Ray Rosé of Pinot – Delicious notes of sun-ripened nectarine, golden raspberry, and honeycomb, complemented by a more subtle strawberry, cantaloupe and aromatic orange zest. The body is clean and refreshing with balanced, crisp acidity and a fresh fruit finish. 7 - 24

13° Celsius Sauvignon Blanc – Crafted from exceptional grapes grown in the world-renowned region of Marlborough, New Zealand. A sublimely elegant wine with vibrant aromatics of citrus, lychee, and sweet herbs. 6 - 18

Kendall Jackson Avant Chardonnay – This refreshing chardonnay erupts with captivating layers of pineapple, bright green apples, fresh Meyer lemon, juicy pear, and wildflowers. 7 - 24

Matchbook Chardonnay – Flavors of sweet fruit, peach pit, and ripe honeydew melon mingle with subtle notes of tropical fruit and butterscotch. The creamy texture is balanced by a bright, crisp finish. 7 - 22
